1. Expenditure under S137 Local Government Act 1972 and S2 Local Government Act 2000

Section 137(1) of the 1972 Act permits the Council to spend on activities for which it has no other specific powers if the Council considers that the expenditure is in the interests of, and will bring direct benefit to, the area or any part of it, or all or some of its inhabitants, providing that the benefit is commensurate with the expenditure. Section 137(3) also permits the Council to incur expenditure for certain charitable and other purposes. The maximum expenditure that can be incurred under both section 137(1) and (3) for the financial year 2021-22 was £8.41 per elector.

In 2021-22, the Council made payments totalling £6523.31 under section 137. These payments are included within 'Other payments' in the Accounting Statement.

- 2. The year end balance is higher than expected which is mainly due to delays from covid. The council had two large planned projects for 2021/22 which were delayed:
 - Melwood Play Area Improvements £44,125.00. Project commenced end of 2021/22 and will be invoiced early 2022/23
 - Millstone Skate Ramps £39,999.00. It was required that the project was deferred until the current projects were completed. £10,000 of this is a National Lottery Grant
