### Pen-y-ffordd Community Council

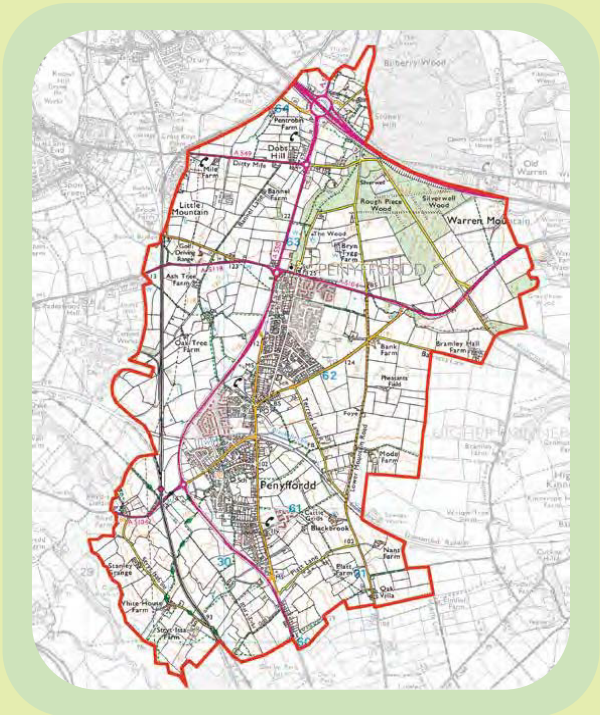
Penyffordd Community Council has thirteen councillors, including the Chairman and Vice Chairman, plus Mrs Sarah Hughes, the Clerk & Responsible Financial Officer and up to two Youth Representatives.

### Community Council Role

The Community Council is the most local level of government, with the ability to make decisions and provide the voice of the community into other layers of government.

### Area

Penyffordd, Penymynydd and Dobshill are covered, see map below, approximately 3,500 electors.



### Communications

There are four noticeboards; Dobshill, Jemoleys, Wellhouse and Watts Road. Website and Facebook.

### Community Council's main areas of responsibility are:

#### Planning

The Council are a statutory consultee for all planning applications in the ward. The council advise the County Council planning officers on the use of Section 106 funds associated with new developments.

#### Environment

Planting, hedge trimming and street cleaning, hedge and grass cutting, benches and seats. Repair and maintenance of Community Council Property. The Community Council employs a part time Litter Picker and a part time Village Groundsman. Liaison with Hanson Cement and Natural Resources Wales. Footpaths and circular walks.



#### Playgrounds

The council is responsible for the management and maintenance of play areas at the Millstone. The play areas at Dobshill, Melwood Close, West View and Ffordd Derwyn are maintained by Flintshire County Council, however, the community council contributes to regular improvements and is involved with the consultation of design.



#### Consultation & Pressure

The council consults and pressures Welsh Government, the Local Authority and other statutory bodies such as Welsh Water.

#### Engagement

The council are actively improving the ward through the actions laid out in the Penyffordd Place Plan.

#### Christmas Lighting

Purchase and installation.

#### Crime and Antisocial Behaviour

The council liaises regularly with our local PCSO and represents the interests of residents affected by crime and anti-social behaviour. Responsibility for CCTV installation and maintenance.

#### Infrastructure

The council contributes towards village facilities such as Community Changing rooms, War Memorial Institute, Memorial Gardens and clock.



#### Community Associations

Councillors are actively engaged with other community organisations including PACA, War Memorial Institute, Penyffordd Bowls Club, Women's Institute, Lions Football Club. Councillors are among the Governors of Ysgol Penyffordd, St John the Baptists school.

#### Financial Assistance

On an annual basis, provides Financial assistance for groups / organisations.

#### Meetings

The public are welcome to attend Council meetings. They are held at 6:30pm on the second Wednesday of every month, normally in the Committee Room at the War Memorial Institute.
