Yellow Lines - Layby - Hawarden Road

Further to communication with Anthony Stanford regarding the recently installed yellow lines on Hawarden Road, there have been strong concerns raised in relation to the safety issues of the yellow lines within the layby.

It is considered that the current road layout is not providing a safe passage for children to walk to school or for pedestrians as a whole. FCC had previously commented when installing the yellow lines that they were required for a health and safety reason - yet the result of the lines in the layby does not offer any safety to the pedestrians.

County Councillor David Williams has informed the Council that during meetings with Anthony Stanford he is insisting that should these be removed it should be at the cost of the Community Council. This is obviously opposed by the Community Council who strongly believe that the yellow lines should have not been installed in the layby and does not offer any safe passage for pedestrians and therefore should be removed at the cost of the County Council.

I would like to take this opportunity to make you aware that the Council have requested that this is an 'open' letter and therefore will be made available for our residents to read on the council website.
